1. All individuals working with or providing care to vertebrate animals and cephalopods must complete the following CITI modules: (1) Working with the IACUC, (2) Reducing Pain and Distress in Laboratory Mice and Rats, and (3) SIUC Animal Care. A surgery module must be completed if performing surgery. Additional taxon specific modules may be required.

2. Once expired, individuals need only take the single refresher course titled: Working with Animals in Biomedical Research - Refresher Course.

3. For the purpose of this regulation, "Investigators" refers to all PD/PI and any other person regardless of title or position, who is responsible for the design, conduct, or reporting of the funded research, including subgrantees, contractors, consortium participants, collaborators, or consultants. PIs are responsible for ensuring all required personnel on their grant who must take FCOI training have done so. FCOI regulations do not apply to phase one Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) or phase one Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) awards.
